3) Paul Kouns Jr. gives an update on the roof. It is over 30 years old. UCEN 1 is the worst, then UCEN 2 (Corwin) and MCC. He shared pics of the rood. There is a lot of equipment up there. Some may be used or replaced. It will be single ply PVC membrane, sheet vinyl product that would fix pooling. It needs more drains. \$652K base price with a \$130K design contingency. Still no quorum

4) Jennifer Hernandez goes over the chiller replacement. She is a project manager at HDAE. Existing chiller pic-terrible! It is on the west side near the loading dock. They are planning instead of 2 units, replacing it with 4 smaller ones. It would provide much needed energy efficiency. They will focus on the areas of need. Original quote was \$500K. Total cost \$758,647K. Construction June 2024, it is in contracts and will go out to bid soon.

5) Louis asked what was the time frame for UCEN 1? They are in the design phase. TBD hopefully summer but it involves dining.

6) Paul comments on the Food Bank, total cost closer to \$170K.
